

**Pleasant View R-VI School Board**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**Tuesday, January 10, 2023**  
**6:00 P.M.**

A regular session board meeting of the Pleasant View R-VI School was held on Monday, January 10, 2023 in the school cafeteria. Board members present were Vice President Damien Little, Treasurer Jack Bethards, Secretary Brenda Allnutt, and members Ben Thomas, Laurie Frisbie and Ben Thomas. Superintendent Rebecca Steinhoff was also present.

The regular session board meeting was called to order by Vice President Damien Little at 6:00 p.m.

**Consent Items:** (agenda, minutes, financial statement and bills)

Motion to approve the consent items was made by Laurie Frisbie and seconded by Tim Miller. Motion carried 5-0.

Avery McCauslin gave an update on the Community Club.

Employee Comments:

Special Education director, Taron Loyd, gave an update on the ECSE preschool as well as the special education program. Mrs. Adriane Todd, kindergarten teacher, gave an update on her class.

**Old Business:**

A. An update on school improvements was given. Window repairs were made during Christmas break by Thermoseal. Discussion was held on replacing the carpet in the 3/4/5 wing this summer with no action taken.

**New Business:**

A. A motion was made by Tim Miller and seconded by Laurie Frisbie to approve a contract with Bluebird (Missouri Network Alliance) as the schools internet provider for an additional year. Motion carried 5-0.

B. No bids were received for a beef or hog. The bid will be reposted for the next meeting.

C. The first reading of MSBA Policy 2022B was held.

D. A motion was made by Ben Thomas and seconded by Jack Bethards to approve the 2023-2024 school calendar. The first day of school will be on August 24<sup>th</sup> and the last day of school will be on May 15<sup>th</sup>.

- E. A motion was made by Ben Thomas and seconded by Jack Bethards to approve the resignation of Board President Danny Westcott effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. His position will not be filled until after the April 4<sup>th</sup> election. Motion carried 5-0.
- F. A motion was made by Tim Miller and seconded by Laurie Frisbie to approve the school's umbrella insurance policy for the 2023 calendar year. The policy holds an amount of \$8,000,000.00 with a premium of \$1,621.00. Motion carried 5-0.
- G. A motion was made by Laurie Frisbie and seconded by Jack Bethards to approve a field trip for the 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade classes to go to Chillicothe Bowling Alley on February 17<sup>th</sup>. Motion carried 5-0.

- A. An enrollment update was given. The ECSE preschool has 23 students, Mrs. Lake's preschool has 20, and kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grades have 115.
