A regular session board meeting of the Pleasant View R-VI School was held Tuesday, December 13, 2022. Board members present were President Danny Westcott, Vice President Damien Little, Treasurer Jack Bethards, and members Jennifer Belvel, Laurie Frisbie and Tim Miller. It was further discussed to paint the exterior of the buildings and update the ground work around the playground equipment, but no action was taken.

C. A motion was made by Damien Little and seconded by Tim Miller to approve the Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Service Plan. Motion carried 6-0.
