A regular session board meeting of the Pleasant View R-VI School was held on Tuesday, February 13, 2024 in the school cafeteria. Board members present were President Damien Little, Vice President Ben Thomas, and members Derek McCauslin, Laurie Frisbie, Jennifer Belvel and Tim Miller. Member, Jack Bethards, was absent. Superintendent, Rebecca Steinhoff, was also present.
