A regular session board meeting of the Pleasant View R-VI School was held on Tuesday, March 12, 2024 in the school cafeteria. B. No new bids were received since last meeting. A bid was received from Troyer Construction for exterior siding in the amount of \$24,973.00. No motion was made to move forward.

C. A motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Laurie Frisbie to approve a bid from The Epoxy Floor Guy in Kearney, Missouri, to lay new floors in the preschool wing, the bathrooms across from the school office, and the bathrooms on the 3/4/5 wing. The bid was in the amount of \$18,773.00 with completion of said project to be done over this upcoming summer. Motion carried 6-0.

D. Discussion was held on MSBA Policy 2023D with no action taken.

New Business:

A. Discussion was held regarding the 2024-2025 school health insurance with no action taken. Amounts have yet to be received from broker.

B. A motion was made by Derek McCauslin and seconded by Laurie Frisbie to approve a track cooperative agreement with Laredo R-VII school district for this spring as well as a cooperative agreement with Trenton R-IX for 2024 fall middle school sports (volleyball, softball, football and cheerleading) as well as winter sport of wrestling. This is contingent on Trenton board approval. Motion carried 6-0.
