- C. A motion was by Tim Miller and seconded by Jennifer Belvel to increase tuition from \$2,250.00 per family to \$2,500.00 per family with a tiered increase of an additional \$300.00 for the second child, \$200.00 for the third child and \$100.00 for the fourth child for the 2025-2026 school year as well as an increase in the weekly After School Program cost from \$25.00 per week to \$30.00 per week for the 2025-2026 school year. Motion carried 6-0.

- D. A motion was made by Derek McCauslin and seconded by Tim Miller to approve MSBA policy update 2025A. Motion carried 6-0.
- E. A motion was made by Laurie Frisbie and seconded by Derek McCauslin to have Keithly Photography be the school's photographer for the 2025-2026 school year. Motion carried 6-0.
