A regular session board meeting of the Pleasant View R-VI School was held on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. in the school's library. Board members present were President Damien Little, Treasurer Jennifer Belvel, Secretary to the Board Brenda Allnutt and members Derek McCauslin, Tim Miller and Zach Harris. Superintendent Rebecca Steinhoff was also present.

The regular session board meeting was called to order by President Damien Little at 6:00 p.m.

Consent Items: (agenda, minutes, financial statement and bills)

A motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Derek McCauslin to approve the consent items. Motion carried 5-0.

Old Business:

A. A motion was made by Zach Harris and seconded by Tim Miller to approve a bid from Paul "Lamar" Byler to install a new window in the kitchen. The amount of the bid was \$558.00. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

A. A motion was made by Derek McCauslin and seconded by Tim Miller to approve the 2025-2026 master schedule with the only changes being early out times will now be 12:30 p.m. instead of 1:20 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.

B. A motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Tim Miller to do a fund transfer on June 30th from fund one to fund two to zero out fund two for the 2024-2025 school year. Motion carried 5-0.

C. A motion was made by Zach Harris and seconded by Tim Miller to amend the 2024-2025 budget on June 30th, 2025, to match the actual revenues and expenditures for the school year. Motion carried 5-0.

D. A motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Zach Harris to approve the 2025-2026 school budget. The budget includes revenues of \$2,380,923.00 and expenses of \$2,381,748 leaving a projected deficit of \$875.00. Motion carried 5-0.

C. A motion was made by Tim Miller and seconded by Derek McCauslin to set the annual tax rate hearing on August 12th at 6:00 p.m. with the regular meeting to follow. Motion carried 5-0.

D. A motion was made by Derek McCauslin and seconded by Zach Harris to approve an agreement with Laredo R-VII for the 2025-2026 school that allows that allows the state money for the Laredo resident students to be claimed and shared with Pleasant View R-VI. Motion carried 5-0.

E. A motion was made by Zach Harris and seconded by Tim Miller on the following bids; Prairie Milk Farms for milk for the 2025-2026 school year (strawberry and chocolate \$.42 and white \$.41), People's Coop for diesel for the 2025-2026 school year (\$2.494 per gallon or -\$.05 under pump price). Motion carried 5-0.

F. A motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Tim Miller to approve MSBA Policy Updates 2025B. Motion carried 5-0.

G. A motion was made by Tim Miller and seconded by Zach Harris to approve the AMI Plan for the 2025-2026 school year. Motion carried 5-0.
