A regular session board meeting of the Pleasant View R-VI School was held on Tuesday, December 10 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in the school library. Board members present were President Damien Little, Vice President Ben Thomas, Treasurer Jennifer Belvel, Secretary to the Board Brenda Allnutt and members Derek McCauslin, Tim Miller and Zach Harris. Superintendent Rebecca Steinhoff was also present.

The regular session board meeting was called to order by President Damien Little at 6:01 p.m.

Consent Items: (agenda, minutes, financial statement and bills)

Motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Derek McCauslin to approve consent items. Motion carried 6-0.

Preschool teacher, Abby Richman, and kindergarten teacher, Adriane Todd, gave updates on their school year.

Old Business:

A. An update on school improvements was given with no action taken.

New Business:

- A. A motion was made by Derek McCauslin and seconded by Tim Miller to approve a field trip request for the students in grades kindergarten through third grade to visit the movie theatre in Trenton on December 20th and the 7th grade class to complete a service project on Wednesday December 18th by visiting Sunnyview Nursing Home and Bristol Manor. Motion carried 6-0.
- B. The board reviewed the school's CSIP Plan with their annual board meeting planned for December 18th.
- C. The board reviewed the Annual Performance review given by DESE for the 2023-2024 school year. Pleasant View received a 96%, which was a significant increase from 2022-2023 with 77%.
- D. The board reviewed changing from targeted Title program to a School-wide Title program with no action taken.

- E. A motion was made by Zach Harris and seconded by Tim Miller to approve MSB Policy Update 2024D. Motion carried 6-0.
- F. A motion was made by Jennifer Belvel and seconded by Tim Miller to approve a bid from BlueBird (Missouri Network Alliance) as the school's internet provider for the 2025 calendar year. Motion carried 6-0.

Superintendent's Report:

- A. Board Filing: An updated was given on board filings. Jennifer Belvel has filed for one of the two three year terms available. The School District is accepting filings for candidacy for the April 8, 2025 election. Candidates may file at the district office during regular school hours (8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.) beginning at 8:00 a.m. December 10, 2024 and ending at 5:00 p.m. on December 31, 2024. Filing will not occur on days in which the district is closed due to inclement weather or sickness, weekends or between the dates of December 23 and December 30, 2024 for winter break. The office will close at 1:30 p.m. on December 20th. The office will be open from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. only on December 31st. The terms expiring are for Jennifer Belvel and Laurie Frisbie.
