Old Business Items

- *Basketball Concessions*
 - o 4 home games completed
 - o Profit of approximately \$1160
 - Last year had 3 home games with approximate profit of \$713
 - Last year averaged \$237 per game
 - This year averaged \$290 per game
 - o Well staffed and well organized so far.
 - o Nachos with meat went over well.
 - o Need to keep an eye on items donated, there was an issue this game season with expired chips being sold without concession volunteer knowledge.
 - o Cafeteria is buying back all leftovers – reimbursement to CC will be up for approval at the next board meeting for a total of \$85.30
 - o Home Games for next season (4, 5, 6th grades)
 - 2/21 and 2/23
 - 1-2 more home games TBD

New Business Items

 - Keep to blue shirt with either black or white lettering.
